Playbook for Life Youth Basketball League Expectations

Referees:

- 1. Conduct yourselves in a Christ-like and respectful manner with coaches, players, and fans during games.
- 2. It is true that you are in control of the game but remember that you are also there for the players, coaches and fans. You are all on the same team.
- 3. Introduce yourselves to the coaches prior to the game.
- 4. Remember that the coaches are not professional coaches. They are parents and may not know the absolute appropriate time to ask a question or all the rules.
- 5. Never talk down to the coaches or treat them disrespectfully. Your goals should be the same, the enjoyment of the game.
- 6. If a coach or player has acted disrespectfully or inappropriately during a game, let you coordinator know as soon as possible.
- 7. If you see that a game is starting to get out of control let the referee coordinator and league director know ASAP someone can get to the gym right away.
- 8. Do not have conversations with parents during or after a game about calls. If a parent or coach approaches you during or after a game do not engage and let the league know as soon as possible.
- 9. It is not required but highly suggested that the referee join the pre-game prayer. This sends a great message to the coaches, players, and fans.
- 10.Players are not allowed to use profanity, taunt, showboat or act in any unsportsmanlike way during a game. A technical foul should be issued to the offending player and the appropriate consequences administered.
- 11.Referees are to call any game as a scrimmage if a team has 3 players show up. It is an official game with 4 players. If it is just a scrimmage because there are only 3 players there from a team, it must be stopped 10 minutes before the next scheduled game. If the game is a scrimmage game and the players are clowning around and not playing correctly then the referees may stop the game.
- 12.Make sure to inform the gym coordinator and referee coordinator of anything that happens during the game that is inappropriate.
