

Playing Time Requirement

Each player on a team must play one continuous full quarter during the game. A continuous full quarter is defined as the beginning of a quarter through its completion.

Exceptions:

- * “AA” Division is not required to follow this rule due to the ages of the players. However, the spirit of the rule should apply in that each player should play at least the equivalent of a full quarter.
- * If any team has more than 10 players at the game, they will be responsible for playing 10 players one full quarter. Additional players beyond 10 must play 2 continuous minutes sometime during the game.
- ***Late Arrivals: If a player arrives anytime during the first half they must meet the regular requirement of playing one continuous quarter. If they arrive after the start of the third quarter, they are eligible to play but are only required to play 2 minutes in that game.**

Penalty: Violation for not playing a player will be forfeiture of the game. It is recommended that coaches verify a player's playing status with the official scorekeeper during halftime to make sure there is no violation.

NOTE: No technical foul will be issued for a player arriving late!!
